## Introducing LeadershipPlenty®

LeadershipPlenty® is a program developed by the Pew Partnership for Civic Change and offered in your community through the Horizons program of the Northwest Area Foundation. It is designed to equip citizens with skills like effective communication, conflict management, and partnership building that they can use to work together as community leaders to reduce poverty.

## LeadershipPlenty® is about Change

Leadership at its core is about change—within individuals, within organizations, and within communities. LeadershipPlenty® was created with the idea that many talented and resourceful citizen leaders are needed to build and maintain a thriving community. The program focuses on bringing those talents and resources to the table to assist communities in achieving their goals.

LeadershipPlenty® operates on two premises that directly apply to the Horizons program. First, it is about the plenty of talent in communities that often goes unused or unasked. And second, it is about the “we” not the “me.” While the skills introduced in LeadershipPlenty® will help you in every phase of your life—family, work, and community—they are intended primarily to help you and your fellow citizens work better together for the common good. They are practical and applicable today and down the road.

## LeadershipPlenty® is designed for a broad range of citizens

The goal of LeadershipPlenty® is to make civic leadership training available to every person in a community. It is especially valuable for:

- Emerging leaders who want to learn new skills in order to address community issues
- Newcomers to a community who have not yet been asked to help
- Young people who want to work with others to effect change
- Established leaders who want to work together for common purposes

There is no lack of leadership in our communities—there are plenty of people with untapped talents that can make their community stronger.
